We are very pleased with our end of KS2 SATs results this year. Our results are all well above the national average. Well done to all the staff and children. Results are as follows:

**Reading, writing and maths:** 77% at expected (National average: 61%)

**Reading:** 85% at expected (National average: 71%)

**Writing Teacher assessment:** 84% at expected (National average: 76%)

**Maths:** 88% at expected (National average: 75%)

**Grammar, punctuation and spelling:** 92% at expected (National average: 77%)
