Maths <u>Positions</u> <u>Numbers within 20</u>	<p>Children will gain an understanding of positional language, as well as directional language for left and right.</p> <p>Children will be able count and write to 20, compare and order numbers, and see patterns within 20. They will also learn different ways to add and subtract numbers within 20.</p>	English <u>Poetry</u> <u>Recount</u> <u>Non-fiction report</u>	<p>Children to identify key features of poetry and perform a class poem to their peers.</p> <p>Children will write a recount as one of the characters from the story.</p> <p>Children will look at key features of a non-fiction text and produce their own report on a polar animal.</p>
Science <u>Everyday Materials</u>	<p>Children to identify and investigate different materials.</p>	Topic <u>Thomas Cook</u>	<p><u>History</u> Children will know about Thomas Cook, who he was and how he changed the way in which people go on holiday. Children will compare holidays today with holidays in Victorian times.</p> <p><u>Geography</u> Children will know the countries, capital cities and seas of the UK. They will be able to describe the location of the 4 countries in the UK and some of the simple characteristics.</p>
Music <u>Rhythm and Pulse</u>	<p>Tap the pulse and rhythm. Follow performance instructions including starting and stopping.</p>	PE <u>Fundamental Skills</u>	<p>Learning spatial awareness, ball skills and keeping safe.</p>
Computing <u>We Are Treasure Hunters</u>	<p>Children will program a toy to move around a map to find buried treasure. They will start by thinking of algorithms for their routes, then input these as stored programs for the robot. They predict how the robot will move and will debug their programs.</p>	<u>Phonics</u> <u>Spelling</u> <u>Handwriting</u>	<p>Phase 3 and Phase 5 phonics, adjacent consonants (2 letters making 2 sounds)</p> <p>Year 1 common exception words</p> <p>Recap of upper and lower case letter formation.</p>
