Maths <u>Numbers up to a million</u> Addition and Subtraction	<p>The children will read, compare, order and round numbers up to 1,000,000. They will also identify patterns in numbers.</p> <p>The children will learn to complete written methods for adding and subtracting numbers up to a million.</p>	English <u>The Highwayman (monologue)</u> <u>The Highwayman (police report)</u>	<p>The children will write a monologue from the perspective of a character in 'The Highwayman' poem.</p> <p>The children will then write a police report about an important event in the poem.</p>
Science <u>Forces</u>	<p>The children will understand and be able to explain the effects of gravity and various types of resistance on objects. They will learn about the importance of pulleys, levers and gears.</p>	Topic <u>Anglo Saxons</u>	<p>Children will learn about the Anglo Saxons, finding out where they came from, why they came, how they lived their lives and their impact on our lives today. The children will also discover what different artefacts can tell us and how these are used to make conclusions.</p>

PE	<p>Children will be learning about strength and conditioning as well as playing invasion games.</p>	R.E. What does it mean to be a Christian?	<p>The children will learn in depth what Christians do at home, in church and in the wider community and the reasons these things are important to them.
