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| Activity                                | How to do it   | Or   |  |
| Minute to win it                        | How many paper cups can you stack into<br>A tower? Start with a row of 5 then 4,3,2,1  | Can you balance the cups on<br>top of each other? Bottom<br>to bottom, or even harder<br>top to top? |  |
| Ring toss                               | Draw a target with circles. Throw a beanbag. How many can you get in the middle?   | Haven't got a beanbag. Use<br>a balled up pair of daddy's<br>socks!!!                                |  |
| Have a mini sports day with your family | Egg and spoon race (not a real egg use a potato).  Hold a ball between your knees.  Blowing through a straw.  Getting dressed up and then running. |  |  |

| Mini paint ball    | If you have a water gun you can make patterns and paintings with it.  |   |
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| Nature Walk        | You will be amazed at all of the things you can collect: Leaves, seeds, twigs, birds feathers, etc.  When you get home place them on a paper towel and arrange into patterns or pictures.   |   |
| Painting pebbles   | Gather some good shaped pebbles. You could paint on them: stripes, spots, fish, or faces, by adding googly eyes.  | You don't need paints, you could make funny faces with eyes, noses and mouths. Or draw on them with a felt-tip pen.                                       |
| Grandma's Suitcase | A memory game, each person has to add to the things in the suitcase by saying they will add one more item at a time.  "My Grandma went on holiday and she packed apair of flippers"  The next person says  "My Grandma went on holiday and she packed apair of flippers and her pet kitten  "My Grandma went on holiday and she packed apair of flippers, her pet kitten and a frying pan"  and so on |   |
| The day trip       | If you go out for the day, take a special toy with you and take photos of it in all of the different places you visit.  | Use a Grown-ups mobile. (With permission of course) take pics of your special toy all over the house doing funny things. Then tell a story with the pics. |

| Go to the library.        | WHEN IT OPENS take a trip to the library. During the summer they often do sessions, or set challenges, to join in with.  | Just borrow a book!  Find a cosy space and share it  with a grown-up. You can go back  the next week to change it for  another one. |
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| Visit the park            | See if you can persuade all the family to visit as many parks as possible during the holiday. You could walk to Spinney Hill, or Victoria. Or go a little further and visit Abbey Park or Brocks Hill. | Help your grown-up to<br>make a picnic before you go.   |
| Make home-made Ice-creams | Fill an ice-cube tray with juice or yoghurt.  Carefully add a little stick at an angle. Put them in the freezer and WAIT. When it is frozen lick it!  Yum yum.   | Get a grown-up to freeze<br>some blueberries or grapes.<br>Then suck on them!!  |
| Wash the car              | Volunteer to help wash the car instead of going to a carwash. Get out the sponges and buckets and make the car shiny!!!!   |   |
