If I add 1 more to a number, the tens digit ALWAYS stays the same. If I find 1 less than a number, the tens digit ALWAYS stays the same. 1 more than 14 is 24.

Can you draw a snowman next to a really cold month?

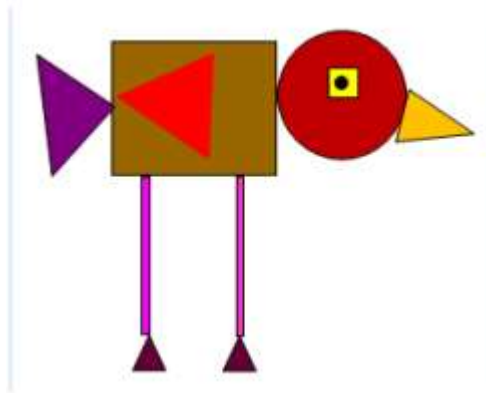
