Tuesday With all this sunny weather, we need to https://www.jpl.nasa.gov/edu/learn/project/how-Science / to-make-a-pinhole-camera/ D&T remember that we can't look directly at the sun. This activity is a creative way for children to safely look at the sun's reflections. Activity: Make a pinhole camera. Materials: 1. Cut a square hole into the middle of one of 2 pieces of white card stock. your pieces of card stock. Aluminium foil. Tape. A pin or paper clip. 2. Tape a piece of aluminum foil over the hole.

	3. Use your pin or paper clip to poke a small hole in the aluminum foil. 4. Place your second piece of card stock on the ground and hold the piece with aluminum foil above it (foil facing up). Stand with the sun behind you and view the projected image on the card stock below! The farther away you hold your camera, the bigger your projected image will be. To make your projection a bit more defined, try putting the bottom piece of card stock in a shadowed area while you hold the other piece in the sunlight.

		game requires 3 or more people so you will	
		need to play with some members of your	
		household.	
		To play:	
		1. One person is chosen to be on one side of	
		the garden/house/field/etc. by themself,	
		with everyone else on the other side. This	
		chosen person is 'it.'	
		2. The person standing alone ('it") gets to say	
		a category of their choice (for example:	
		colors, teachers, candy bars, etc.).	
		3. Once the topic is announced, the rest of	
		the players (quietly, so 'it' doesn't hear)	
		state what they are (if the topic is "colours",	
		one person is yellow, another is green).	
		Everyone needs a different answer.	
		4. Once everyone is ready, 'it' shouts out one	
		of the words such as yellow (depending on	
		the topic picked). If the word chosen is not	
		being used by one of the players, the person	
		who is "it" tries again with another word.	
		5. Once 'it' shouts a word that matches one	
		of the answers picked, 'it' and the player	
		with the corresponding color, race across to	
		see who reaches the other side first (they	
		will be running in opposite directions).	

		6. When they reach the opposite side, they grab it and shout "toothpaste"! 7. Whoever wins and shouts it first is now 'it' and gets to decide a new topic!
