**Prepare and make food**

Today we will be preparing and making a traditional dish from Mexico,

**Fajitas.**



**You MUST ask an adult to help you make the Fajita's. Using knives and heated equipment can be dangerous.**


<u>Ingredients</u>	<u>What to do</u>
Chicken diced	1. Heat the oil in a large frying pan on a high heat.
1 tbsp oil	2. Add the peppers, frying for another couple of minutes
1 red pepper cut into strips	3. Add the soy sauce, if using.
1 yellow pepper cut into strips	4. Fry for a further 5-10 minutes, ensuring all of the chicken is fully cooked through.
2 tsp garlic granules	5. Tip the fajita mix into a large serving bowl
1/2 tsp smoked paprika	6. Microwave the tortilla wraps on a plate for 30-60 seconds according to the pack instructions. This isn't essential, but it warms and softens the tortillas and tends to make them taste better.
1 tsp reduced salt soy sauce (leave out entirely for small children)	7. Lay the table with the chicken mix, tortillas, cheese, tomatoes and lettuce.
8 soft tortilla wraps	8. Allow everyone to enjoy putting it all together themselves and eating!
100 g (3.5 oz) cheddar grated	
100 g (3.5 oz) lettuce shredded	
100 g (3.5 oz) cherry tomatoes halved
