



**Year 2 Activities for other subjects Week beginning 18<sup>th</sup> MAY**

Draw a picture of this place in your book and write 5 sentences to describe why it is so special to you.</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> If you have the internet, we'd like you to research the modern wonder of the world - <b>Petra</b> Research the key facts about '<b>Petra</b>' Use the save search engine '<b>Kidrex</b>'.</p> <p>Find out the continent, country, when and why it was built, name the highest mountain and the longest river from that country. In your work books, record 6 facts about the wonder of the world. <p><b>Tuesday 19th</b></p>	<p><b>D &amp; T</b></p> 	<p><b>Petra</b> is one of the 'Wonders of the World' - We are going to explore foods from <b>Jordan</b>.</p> <p><u>Task 1</u> Traditional ingredients in Jordan are, rice, flat bread, lamb, roasted nuts, yoghurt sauce and chickpeas. Can you draw a traditional healthy plate using some of the ingredients from Jordan?</p>  <p><u>Task 2</u> Do some research and discuss with your families traditional dishes from Jordan. In your workbook, make a list of popular dishes from Jordan. Can you list the ingredients? Can you draw a labelled picture of the traditional food from Jordan?</p>	<p>Purple mash activity:</p> <p>Search 'cooking', click on the 'food' icon, click the paint project 'plate' - paint a project to design your own traditional dish from Jordan. Remember to save your work for your teacher to see.</p>
