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Wednesday 1st	Science	<p><u>Marvellous Mirrors</u></p> <p>Game 2 - Mirror Maze (YOU WILL NEED AN ADULT FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS YOU WILL NEED TO USE A SMALL MIRROR)</p> <p>For this game, walk along a wavy line while looking only in a mirror held overhead. You could make a trail using leaves or stones in the garden to follow or indoors.</p> <p>Draw and write about your findings.</p> <p>Other Activities:</p> <p>Draw Why not draw a mirror portrait? Look at it: your face in a mirror and draw what you see!</p> <p>Reflect Use a mirror to create a symmetrical pattern. Position the mirror on the centre line and ensure the pattern is the same on both sides of this mirror line.</p> <p>Write Can you write a non-fiction book all about it: mirrors and reflective surfaces? Explain what a mirror is, why it reflects light so well, and how they can be useful. Add some helpful diagrams and illustrations.</p>	<p>BBC Bite Size</p> <p>Purple Mash - Science - Light and dark</p>
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Thursday 2nd	Music	<p>Pulse and rhythm</p> <p>Pulse is a steady beat like a ticking clock or your heartbeat.</p> <p>Rhythm is the pattern of long and short sounds that fit with the pulse as you move through the song. You don't need instruments to make music. You can start making music by creating a simple pulse. A pulse can be made with claps or taps.</p> <p>Once you have a pulse you can start adding rhythms to make the music more interesting.
