




























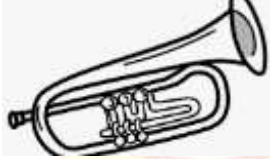
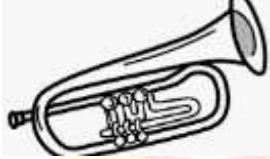
## Year 4 Activities for other subjects Week beginning 1<sup>st</sup> June
