Spelling: List as many homophones as you can.	Write sentences using each homophone correctly.	Purple Mash Choose a spelling quiz
Maths: Choose 6 two digit numbers and multiply them by 10 and show your working out.	Multiply the same 6 numbers by 100 and 1000 showing your working out.	My maths: as set (check daily) Purple Mash (through J2E) Times tables practise

English: Read for 30 minutes with an adult or brother or sister.	Identify any new vocabulary from your AR book and write down their meanings.	Purple Mash (English) Use 2Create a story to make your own story
Spelling: Find words that follow the 'ably' and 'ibly'.	Practise spelling 10 of the words you have found.	Purple Mash Choose a spelling quiz
Maths: Practise dividing by 10. Choose 6 numbers to divide by 10. For example: 19 divided by 10 = 1.9	Divide the same 6 numbers by 100 and 1000 remembering to show your working out.	My maths: as set (check daily) Purple Mash (Number activity)

<u>THURSDAY</u>	<u>Challenge activities</u>	<u>Additional activities</u>
English: Read for 30 minutes with an adult or brother or sister.	Write a setting description from your AR book.	Purple Mash (English) Choose a talking story or other story
Grammar: Write 5 sentences that include adjectives and an adverb. For example: The small boy ran quickly to the park.	Write 8 complex sentences using an embedded clause e.g. Jamie, who was very excited, opened his birthday present first thing in the morning.	Purple Mash (English) Grammar games (Early Bird) Choose one
Maths: Practise adding numbers together. 2 digit add a 2 digit. For example: 24 + 63 = 87	Write more challenging addition questions up to 4 digit add 4 digit. Remember to show your working out.	My maths: as set (check daily) Purple Mash (Dividers)

<u>FRIDAY</u>	<u>Challenge activities</u>	<u>Additional activities</u>
English: Read for 30 minutes with an adult or brother or sister.	Write 5 interesting sentences using subordinating conjunctions (if, so, therefore, after, although, before etc.) For example: Before going to the park, Mohammed ate his breakfast.	Purple Mash (English) Choose a story
Spelling: List as many synonyms for the word 'big'. Practise spelling these.	Make a list of different synonyms and antonyms. E.g. bad- good (antonyms). Happy- thrilled (synonyms)	Purple Mash (English) Choose a spelling or grammar activity.
Maths: Add and subtract decimals E.g. $0.67 + 1.38$ $1.86 - 0.18$	'Show it, draw it, explain and prove it' for any addition of decimals number sentence.	My Maths: as set (check daily) Purple Mash (Bond Bubbles) Choose a maths paint project
