





#### Spelling:

Spelling Strategy Examples

#### Rainbow Writing

Using coloured pencils in different ways can help to make parts of words memorable. You could highlight the tricky parts of the word or write the tricky part in a different colour. You could also write each letter in a different colour, or write the word in red, then overlay in orange, yellow and so on.

#### Pyramid Practise

Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check

Monster SATs

Purple Mash (English) Grammar (Early Bird) – Bella and the Farm and the Dog and the Ball.

Look: first look at the whole word carefully and if there is one part of the word that is difficult, look at that part in more detail.

<u>Say:</u> say the word as you look at it, using different ways of pronouncing it if that will make it more memorable.

Cover: cover the word.

Write: write the word from memory, saying the

word as you do so.

<u>Check:</u> Have you got it right? If yes, try writing it again and again! If not, start again - look, say, cover, write, check.
