Monday	Half Term News! Have a go at drawing a picture of something you did during the half term holiday. Ask your grown-up to write a sentence about it underneath. Make a valentine's day card for someone you love! Have a look at the bottom of the page for some ideas!
Tuesday	Ways to say I love you! Stick down the words 'I love ...' in your book and then draw a picture of someone you love! (Mummy/Daddy/Nani/Auntie/etc)	Join in with Mrs Storey's phonics video! Have a go on your own!	Print off the dominoes we have sent or make your own 1,2,3 dominoes. Play a game with dominoes with someone is your house. Can you match the dots?	Show someone you live with that you love them! Can you make them something? Do something kind for them? Help them to do something? Or even just give them a big cuddle!

Wednesday	Read the ingredients list we sent you for making pancakes! Collect the ingredients you need and follow the recipe to make your own pancakes!	Find these objects that rhyme in your house! hat / cat sock / rock bin / tin star / jar coat / boat	Ask your grown-up to write the number 1, 2 and 3 onto the back of paper pancakes! Pop them in a frying pan and try to flip them! Can you read the number it lands on? 	Can you make a paper chef hat? The you can be the chef and make pancakes! 
Thursday	Practice the handwriting patterns Miss Alhaddad showed you in the remote learning session today!	Hunt for things beginning with 'p' in your house and have a go at playing Silly Soup like Miss Alhaddad! (pancake/pen/paper/ pillow/ pear/ pan/ potato / pasta)	Ask your grown up to write: 1 2 3 in your home learning books. Now draw 1, 2, and 3 pancakes next to the right number!	Get crafty with ... pasta! Can you make a collage? Thread it to make a necklace? Make a pattern?
Friday	Sight word colouring activity! Colour each sight word on the page we sent you, the right colour! Then stick it into your Home Learning Book! Can you find the words in any of your stories at home? Send us a video of your pattern!	Sing the 5 crispy pancakes song (we will send you the words) to the tune of 5 current buns. Use the pancakes that you have made to help you count!	Have a go at making your own pancakes. Follow the recipe we have sent you.
