Topic this week...

Hello again everyone! We hope you are all well, and managing to stick with us! This week we will continue our topic about traditional tales! This week's story is called 'The Gingerbread Man'. We will learn all about baking! We will read the story and sing some songs together, and maybe even have a go at baking some gingerbread men ourselves!

These are suggestions for you to do at home with your child, each activity should last around 15/20 minutes. Also please join in with the online activities when you can.

	Reading / Sight words/ Handwriting	Phonics	Maths	Let's Get Busy!
Monday	Read the Twinkl ebook of The Gingerbread Man! (Link sent by Miss Alhaddad)	https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/stories/melody-gingerbread-man Watch how Melody explores The Gingerbread Man through music! Can you run like the Gingerbread Man when the music sounds like running?	Watch this video all about 1! https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7APNVVdrx5M	Make your own gingerbread chain. Ask your grown up to help you draw and cut out a gingerbread chain like this one:  Can you decorate them in different ways?
Tuesday	Have a look at the 'Kitchen Safety' poster we sent you. Talk with someone you live with about what dangers you can see. Can you print it off and stick it into your HL book? Try circling the dangers you spot! If you can't print, try drawing 2 kitchen dangers in your HL book.	Join in with Mrs Storey's roboting video! See if you can shout out which word she is roboting!	Have a go at playing this game! Can you count how many buttons the Gingerbread man has? https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/gingerbread-man-game	The Gingerbread man is a really fast runner! Can you practice running really fast? Try running around your home 3 times as fast as you can! See if someone can time you!

Wednesday	Ask your grownup to write lots of number 1s, 2s and 3s in your home learning book. Can you colour in all the number 1s?	https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/alphablocks-man The alphablocks spell out the word 'm a n' and make a gingerbread man! See if you can say the sounds along with them! m - a - n	When we bake we often use weighing scales. Ask your grown-up if it is ok to have a go with their kitchen weighing scales (if you have one). Try weighing different objects and seeing which is the heaviest. Try spooning flour into a bowl! Can you make 100g?	Have a go at role playing your own bakery! Can you dress up like a baker and sell what you bake to your grown ups? (You can sell anything, plastic or real food would work perfectly!)
Thursday	Practice the handwriting patterns Miss Alhaddad showed you in the remote learning session today!	Hunt for things beginning with 't' in your house and have a go at playing Silly Soup like Miss Alhaddad! (tap/tomato/toothbrush/top/topi/toilet(!)/towel)	Practice writing, tracing and coping the number 1 in to your home learning book.	Get crafty with...paper plates! Use a paper plate to make your own gingerbread mask. Think about what you can use to decorate it!
Friday	Print off (or ask your grown up to copy into your book) and order the Gingerbread Man recipe cards! Can you put them in the right order?	Sing the Gingerbread Man song with Mrs Storey in her video! You could have a go at making some puppets like hers to use as you sing!	Sing Mrs Storey's 5 Gingerbread Men song with a 5 frame!	Have a go at baking your own gingerbread men. Have a go at following the recipe that you ordered. (if you can't bake, ask your grown up to give you some roti dough and cut out some gingerbread men from that)
