Bad weather

Now the weather is getting colder, it is important that all children have a suitable coat and shoes to wear outside. We have been very lucky so far this winter but if it does get icy, it is important that children are careful walking on the pavements. The school would only close if the weather was very bad and if it was dangerous for staff and children to get to school. Allergies

We do have children in school who have severe allergies to nuts and some fruits. It is really important that no nuts or food containing nuts are part of packed lunches. This includes packed lunches provided when children go on trips.

It is also really important that any sweets that are sent in for birthdays do not contain nuts. We know it is important for children to celebrate their birthday with their friends but would like to encourage parents to only send in small treats for the children. Other nice ideas are small stationary items. Please do not send birthday cakes as they may contain nuts.

Assemblies

F1 Admissions
